



Job Opportunity

SEN PRE-SCHOOL ASSISTANT (PART TIME)

Duties of the role include:

- ◆ To work in a 1 to 1 capacity with a child that has additional needs.
- ◆ To supervise and help with social interactions, modelling positive behaviour, safety and social skills. To work on language development away from peers.
- ◆ To support with daily routines including lunchtimes and toileting needs.
- ◆ As a key person you will need to observe, monitor, and record their development.
- ◆ To work with SENCO and other professions to implement any educational programmes.
- ◆ To support with transition into school.
- ◆ To also be a reliable member of the team, working co-operatively and with flexibility
- ◆ To participate in setting up activities and tidying away when necessary. This will require some physical ability in lifting and moving of equipment.
- ◆ To work with other team members to implement the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) as part of day to day duties and within the guidelines set out by Ofsted.
- ◆ To work within all other agreed policies
- ◆ To undertake any other reasonable duties as directed by the Nursery School Manager.
- ◆ Be willing to attend further training courses and update your skills as required.

Hours of work

- ◆ Initially 6 hours per week across Monday, & Thursday. Possibly more over time. Flexible timings.
- ◆ Possibility of further, non-SEN focussed shifts

Qualifications & experience required:

- ◆ Previous experience of childcare or working in a preschool desirable.
- ◆ Paediatric first aid and Safeguarding desirable but not essential as training is offered.
- ◆ Previous SEN experience in a pre-school environment would be desirable.
- ◆ Good organisational and communication skills are essential.

Salary:

- £9.50-£9.79 per hour, depending on experience.
